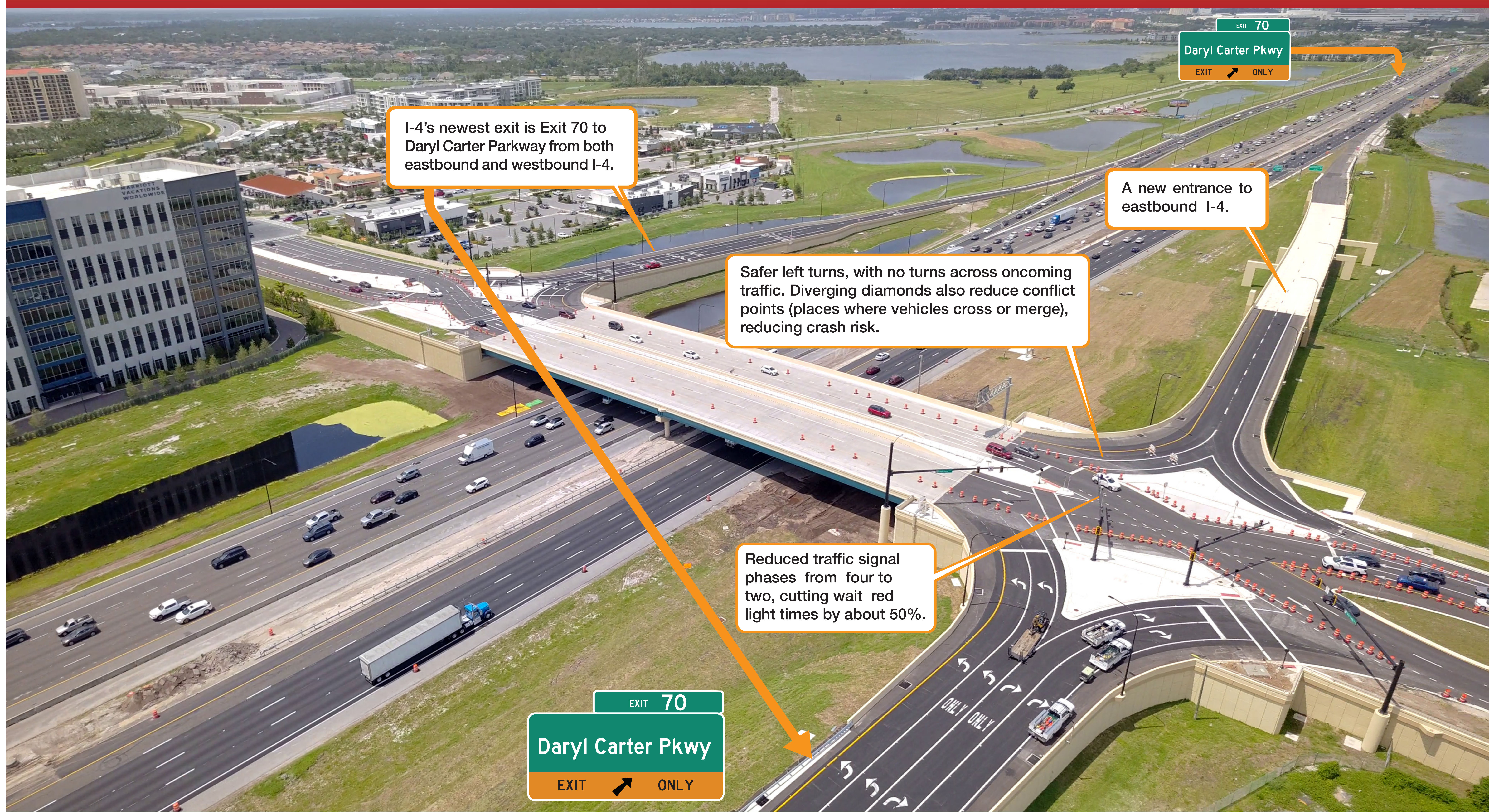




The New I-4 Diverging Diamond Interchange at Daryl Carter Parkway

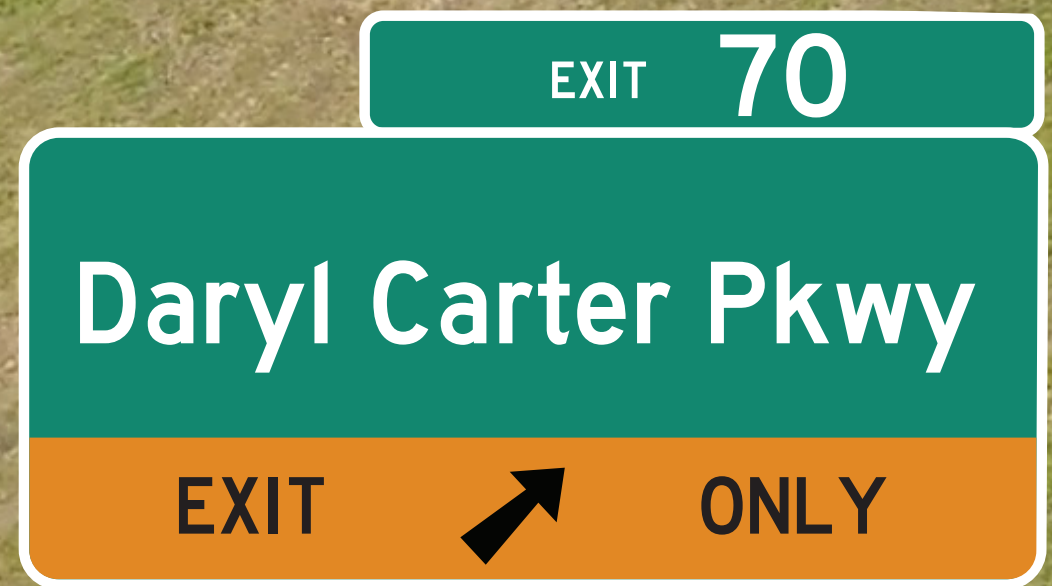


I-4's newest exit is Exit 70 to Daryl Carter Parkway from both eastbound and westbound I-4.

A new entrance to eastbound I-4.

Safer left turns, with no turns across oncoming traffic. Diverging diamonds also reduce conflict points (places where vehicles cross or merge), reducing crash risk.

Reduced traffic signal phases from four to two, cutting wait red light times by about 50%.



Benefits compared to a traditional interchange:



Safer: The DDI design eliminates left turns across oncoming traffic for vehicles turning onto or off of the interstate – cutting the risk of crashes in half.

More Efficient: With fewer traffic signal phases required, nearly twice as many vehicles can pass through the interchange in the same amount of time.
