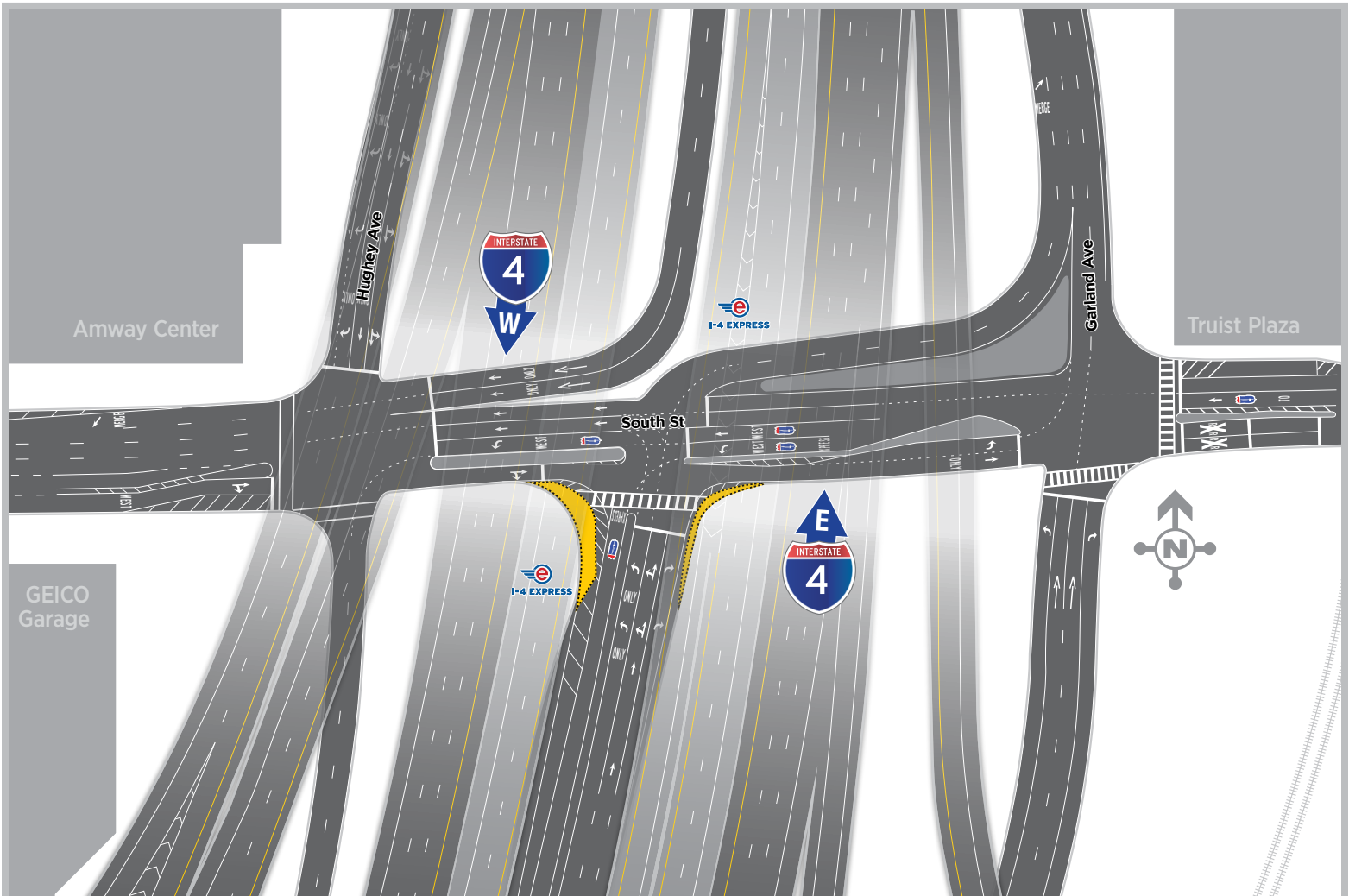

NEW CONFIGURATION OF SOUTH STREET TO PERMIT TWO-WAY TRAFFIC

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is improving mobility in the downtown Orlando area by reconfiguring South Street under Interstate 4 (I-4) into a two-way street. Construction is anticipated to start as soon as January 21 and should be completed in March. The new traffic pattern will simplify movement and enable continuous eastbound travel for motorists entering and exiting I-4 Express. The project will also improve pedestrian safety by adding larger pedestrian refuge areas and shortening the crosswalk on South Street at the end of the eastbound I-4 Express off ramp.



The improved refuge areas protect pedestrians with a new sustainable barrier made with recycled materials. The additional space shortens the distance that a pedestrian has to cross, reducing the risk of conflict with vehicles.

Motorists should expect overnight closures of South Street under I-4 for construction and lane striping. For detour information, please visit fdot.tips/south.
