Update on Interstate 4 Improvement Projects in Seminole County

Financial Project ID Nos. 439682-2, -3, -4, -5

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), is hosting an informational open house about improvements to Interstate 4 (I-4) in Seminole County. These traffic operation and capacity improvement projects will help keep traffic flowing more smoothly and safely on eastbound I-4 and will lay the groundwork for future improvements. The projects include reconstructing the E.E. Williamson Road overpass and adding a lane on eastbound I-4 from E.E. Williamson Road to Lake Mary Boulevard. It also includes resurfacing eastbound I-4 from west of Lake Mary Boulevard to County Road 46A and State Road 46 to the Volusia County line.
