

The Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) Industry Forum provides an opportunity for design-build teams, including contractors, subcontractors, and design consultants, to learn more about the elements and considerations of this interchange project. This project also includes an 8-mile extension of a single westbound I-4 managed lane from west of S.R. 536 to the I-4 Ultimate project and widening of the westbound I-4 ramp to eastbound Beachline Expressway (S.R. 528). Attendance is not mandatory but is recommended for firms considering bidding on the project. Advance registration is required by filling out the online form at **i4Beyond.com/industry.**
