

<div data-bbox="210 706 514 787"> <h3>Purpose of This Public Meeting</h3> </div> <div data-bbox="231 803 441 1031"> <p>FPID: 448914-1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ I-4 and Apopka-Vineland Road (S.R. 535) interchange <p>FPID: 449771-1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Single, buffer-separated, westbound managed lane on I-4 from west of S.R. 536 to west of Daryl Carter Parkway </div> <div data-bbox="514 698 840 1031"> </div> <div data-bbox="630 1031 840 1055"> <p>FPID Nos. 242592-6 and 242592-8</p> </div> <div data-bbox="840 1031 882 1055"> <p>#8</p> </div>	<p>The Florida Department of Transportation would like to welcome you to the public meeting for improvements to the public meeting for improvements to the I-4 at Apopka-Vineland Road / State Road 535 interchange in Orange County.</p> <p>The purpose of these projects is to partially reconstruct the interchange to enhance safety and improve access to and from westbound I-4 and to add capacity to I-4.</p> <p>The project, Financial Project Identification numbers 448914-1 and 449771-1, will improve efficiency and safety at the interchange.</p> <p>As part of this project, a single, buffer-separated, westbound express lane will be constructed from west of S.R. 536 to west of Daryl Carter Parkway. This express lane will be built in three separate projects extending from west of S.R. 536 to west of Sand Lake Road.</p>
	<p>The first part of the project we will review is the interchange at I-4 and Apopka-Vineland Road, also known as State Road 535.</p>



	<p>Traffic counts at this intersection continue to rebound following a brief decline in 2020. More than 45,000 vehicles travel through this intersection every day.</p> <p>To ensure this interchange continues to operate efficiently and safely as a key roadway in Orlando's busy tourist corridor, upgrades are needed to account for the additional vehicle trips and increased periods of congestion. During heavy periods of congestion, traffic can back up on the interchange ramps. Extending the ramp will provide added capacity.</p>
	<p>The proposed enhancements to the interchange will increase traffic efficiency and provide additional capacity. These improvements include:</p> <p>Lengthening and realigning the westbound I-4 entrance ramp from southbound Apopka-Vineland Road, improving traffic flow and giving motorists more time to merge onto I-4;</p> <p>Milling and resurfacing Apopka-Vineland Road; Constructing a new loop ramp from northbound Apopka-Vineland Road to westbound I-4. The ramp will enhance safety and mobility by eliminating the need for motorists to turn left across traffic;</p> <p>Lengthening the westbound I-4 exit ramp to Apopka-Vineland Road to provide additional capacity.</p>

The anticipated production schedule for the I-4 and Apopka-Vineland Road interchange improvement project is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public meeting in February 2023; • FDOT will select a contractor in summer 2023; • Design completion is expected in fall of 2023; and • Construction is expected to begin by the end of 2023.
	<p>This design-build project also includes I-4 capacity improvements from west of State Road 536 to west of Daryl Carter Parkway.</p> <p>The Florida Department of Transportation is providing a new option for longer trips on I-4. This project will add a single, buffer-separated, westbound express lane to I-4. This express lane will be constructed as parts of three separate projects, including the I-4 interchange improvement projects at Daryl Carter Parkway and Sand Lake Road.</p> <p>When completed, the express lane will extend from west of Central Florida Parkway (also known as State Road 536) to west of Sand Lake Road.</p>
