
The blue arrows in both images point to where you will find the Question box.

Then click Send to submit your comment or question to staff.



The Florida Department of Transportation would like to welcome you to Purpose of This the public meeting for improvements to the public meeting for **Public Meeting** improvements to the I-4 at Apopka-Vineland Road / State Road 535 FPID: 448914-1 interchange in Orange County. ■I-4 and Apopka-Vineland Road (S.R. 535) interchange The purpose of these projects is to partially reconstruct the interchange to FPID: 449771-1 ■ Single, buffer-separated. enhance safety and improve access to and from westbound I-4 and to add westbound managed lane on I-4 from west of S.R. capacity to I-4. 536 to west of Darvl Carter Parkway The project, Financial Project Identification numbers 448914-1 and #8 FPID Nos. 242592-6 and 242592-8 449771-1, will improve efficiency and safety at the interchange. As part of this project, a single, buffer-separated, westbound express lane will be constructed from west of S.R. 536 to west of Daryl Carter Parkway. This express lane will be built in three separate projects extending from west of S.R. 536 to west of Sand Lake Road. The first part of the project we will review is the interchange at I-4 and Apopka-Vineland Road, also known as State Road 535.

Traffic counts at this intersection continue to rebound following a brief decline in 2020. More than 45,000 vehicles travel through this intersection every day.
To ensure this interchange continues to operate efficiently and safely as a key roadway in Orlando's busy tourist corridor, upgrades are needed to account for the additional vehicle trips and increased periods of congestion. During heavy periods of congestion, traffic can back up on the interchange ramps. Extending the ramp will provide added capacity.
The proposed enhancements to the interchange will increase traffic
efficiency and provide additional capacity. These improvements include:
Lengthening and realigning the westbound I-4 entrance ramp from southbound Apopka-Vineland Road, improving traffic flow and giving motorists more time to merge onto I-4;
NAIlling and recomfesing Anaphy Vincland Dood.
Milling and resurfacing Apopka-Vineland Road;
Constructing a new loop ramp from northbound Apopka-Vineland Road to
westbound I-4. The ramp will enhance safety and mobility by eliminating
the need for motorists to turn left across traffic;
Lengthening the westbound I-4 exit ramp to Apopka-Vineland Road to provide additional capacity.
