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I-4 Beyond the Ultimate begins repaving westbound Interstate 4 in Seminole County

Project includes travel lanes between Seminole-Volusia county line and Lake Mary Boulevard

Seminole County, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is beginning the milling & resurfacing of westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from U.S. 17-92 to State Road (S.R.) 46 and from County Road (C.R.) 46A to Lake Mary Boulevard on Sunday, June 21.

During this repaving, motorists can expect nightly lane closures on westbound I-4 in Seminole County and ramp closures at the U.S. 17-92, S.R. 46, C.R. 46A and Lake Mary Boulevard interchanges.

Other ongoing I-4 Beyond the Ultimate work in Seminole County includes:

- Reconstruction and widening of the E.E. Williamson Road bridge over I-4.
- Addition of an auxiliary lane to eastbound I-4 from the end of the I-4 Ultimate project to west of Lake Mary Boulevard.

Both directions of I-4 between C.R. 46A and S.R. 46 will be repaved as part of the Wekiva Parkway Section 8 Extension which began construction in fall 2019.
