Ryan Flipse: Between Areas 3 and 4, there is a lot of dirt and earth piled up in preparation for the diversion that is coming up. We also removed vegetation near area 5. We are currently working in Areas 1 and 2 mowing and removing vegetation. In Areas 6 and 7 we are weed eating. We have our subcontractor as well as FDOT performing mowing. We are looking at Area 5 and seeing if that would be a good area to implement some opportunities to lessen the maintenance.

David Vallillo: Yes, Area 5 is the only place where we have had any feedback, and more recently Area 7. We have seen improvements in Area 5.

Ryan: Mowing in Area 7 should be addressed today.

Ryan: The biggest opportunity for temporary planting would be when we implement the initial DDI. We encourage that if anyone has seen any examples, to please send them over to us.

David: We know there are constantly changing variables like weather and constantly changing construction. When we started discussing the topic of temporary planting, we decided it might not be feasible right now. Right now, it might be better to focus on mowing and keeping the vegetation in-check. We are not sure if the temporary planning would have the results we would like at this stage.

Ryan: Once we get 100 percent plans, we will have a better idea on what may be feasible. We have come to an agreement on the price for the Clean Team and now it is in the approval process. Until we implement the interim DDI, we don't anticipate a large need for it. We are looking at January or Feb at the earliest for implementing the interim DDI. We also received a price for the sweeper truck, but we are investigating and fleshing out the details of the quote to make sure we are on the same page before we either accept or negotiate it. It will probably be another month or two before we go through their quote and make sure we are still on the same page as far as duration, who owns the sweeper truck, etc.
