Construction Improvements Near Your Community



Dear Resident/ Property Owner:

Improvements near Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road (State Road 482) are underway, and the contractor plans to begin pile driving in your area as soon as this month. Piles are long, vertical structures made of steel or concrete that are placed deep into the ground to provide safe foundations for various structures like bridges. We will keep you informed of upcoming activities as the project progresses.

Pile installation will occur during the day.

Construction Pile Driving Near Your Community

Q. What is pile driving?

A. Pile driving is a process of installing piles into the ground to provide a safe and stable foundation to hold structures like bridges. The piles are driven into the ground by a large hammer mounted on a crane.

Q. How noisy is pile driving?

A. The pile driver will emit a hammering noise while in operation. From 50 feet away, the noise level will range from 90 to 100 decibels — around the same noise level as a garbage truck or chain saw. Pile driving will only occur during daytime hours, between 7 a.m. to 10 p.m., to minimize the impact to residents.

Q. Where is pile driving taking place?

A. Construction activities are taking place near Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road (State Road 482). The interchange is being reconstructed as a diverging diamond interchange. The project will reconfigure and lengthen ramps at the interchange. The project will also improve capacity by replacing the existing left turns from westbound Sand Lake Road to southbound Turkey Lake Road with a new loop ramp.
