FDOT Project Manager</p>	<p>Abhijeet Desai on Camera (preproduced – pick up from 2022 meeting video): Good evening, everyone, and welcome to the public meeting for project plans at the County Road 46A and Rinehart Road intersection near Interstate 4, and the I-4 and U.S. 17-92 interchange.</p> <p>My name is Abhijeet Desai, and I am the project manager with the Florida Department of Transportation, or FDOT.</p> <p>During the meeting, we will present information on the Department’s plans to improve safety and enhance operations through these projects.</p>

 <p>Purpose County Road (C.R.) 46A (H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway) and Rinehart Road intersection Interstate 4 (I-4) and U.S. 17-92 interchange <small>Financial Project Identification (FPID) Nos. 242592-6, 242592-8</small></p> <p style="text-align: right;">#8</p>	<p>The Florida Department of Transportation would like to welcome you to the public meeting for improvements to two intersections in Seminole County. The purpose of these projects is to provide operational and safety improvements. The public meeting is being held to present information and receive community feedback.</p> <p>The first project, Financial Project Identification number 242592-6, consists of improvements to the County Road 46A and Rinehart Road intersection. This project will increase capacity at the intersection by modifying select existing turn lanes and adding new turn lanes.</p> <p>The second project, Financial Project Identification number 242592-8, involves safety improvements to the I-4 and U.S. 17-92 interchange by improving sight distance for motorists, upgrading crosswalks for pedestrians and bicyclists, and reducing the speed limit from 50 mph to 35 mph.</p>

<p>C.R. 46A AT RINEHART ROAD</p>  <p>FPID No. 242592-6 #9</p> <p>First a map that shows only the 46A and Rinehart project, in relation to I-4, Heathrow, Lake Mary and Sanford, and then b-roll of the area.</p>	<p>The first project we will review is the County Road 46A and Rinehart Road intersection improvement. Traffic counts at this intersection continue to rebound following a brief decline in 2020. More than 42,000 vehicles travel through this intersection every day.</p> <p>To ensure this intersection continues to operate efficiently and safely, upgrades are needed to account for the additional vehicle trips and increased periods of congestion. How this intersection functions directly affects the I-4 and County Road 46A interchange. During periods of heavy congestion, traffic can back up on the interchange ramps. Improving how the County Road 46A and Rinehart Road intersection operates will have a positive effect on how the adjoining interchange functions.</p> <p>Now let's talk about the improvements for the intersection.</p>
<p>CHANGES TO 46A & RINEHART ROAD</p>  <p>FPID No. 242592-6 #10</p> <p>Zoom in and out of the improvements as they are read. Same map and improvements that are listed on the handout:</p>	<p>The enhancements to the County Road 46A and Rinehart Road intersection will increase traffic efficiency while reducing congestion onto the I-4 and County Road 46A interchange. These improvements include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Converting the existing eastbound through/right-turn lane on County Road 46A to a through-only lane and adding two right-turn-only lanes for a total of three to southbound Rinehart Road; 2) Adding a third lane to southbound Rinehart Road between County Road 46A and Timacuan Boulevard; 3) Extending the northbound left-turn lanes on Rinehart Road to westbound County Road 46A; 4) Adding a second southbound right-turn lane on Rinehart Road to westbound County Road 46A; and 5) Extending the westbound County Road 46A to southbound Rinehart Road turn lane.

<p>C.R. 46A – RINEHART ROAD SCHEDULE</p>  <p>FPID No. 242592-6 #11</p>	<p>The anticipated production schedule for the County Road 46A and Rinehart Road intersection improvement project is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The original design public meeting was held in August 2022;• The project was awarded in June of 2023;• Construction began in October 2023; and• The completion of the project is expected in 2025.
<p>I-4 AND U.S. 17-92 INTERCHANGE</p>  <p>FPID No. 242592-8 #12</p> <p>Same as Slide 9, except now it's for the 17-92 project. The zoomed out map just needs to show the St Johns River, I-4 and the zoo (there's not much else around there)</p>	<p>The next project we will review is the improvements at the I-4 and U.S. 17-92 interchange. The goals of this project are to improve traffic operations, improve pedestrian and bicycle safety, and to better manage vehicle speeds on U.S. 17-92.</p> <p>The City of Sanford's recently completed River-Walk Phase III project extended the multi-use trail along Seminole Boulevard between North Mellonville Avenue and U.S. 17-92 near the I-4 interchange. The safety of all road users is the top priority for the Florida Department of Transportation. More than 35,000 vehicles use U.S. 17-92 every day in this area.</p>

<p>I-4 AND U.S. 17-92 INTERCHANGE</p>  <p>FPID No. 242592-8 13</p> <p>#13</p> <p>Zoom in and out of the improvements as they are read. Same map and improvements that are listed on the handout:</p>	<p>The enhancements will increase safety at the I-4 and U.S. 17-92 interchange in Seminole County by improving sight distance for motorists, upgrading crosswalks for pedestrians and bicyclists, and reducing the speed limit from 50 mph to 35 mph. These improvements include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Realigning the eastbound I-4 exit ramp to U.S. 17-92 westbound to improve sight distance and adding crosswalk improvements, including a pedestrian-activated crossing signal;2) Adding an auxiliary lane on eastbound U.S. 17-92 between the westbound I-4 exit ramp and Monroe Road;3) Adding a second right-turn lane from U.S. 17-92 when driving east to continue south on U.S. 17-92/Monroe Road. The dual right-turn-only lanes will stop at the signalized intersection with Seminole Boulevard, replacing the existing free-flow right turn;4) Adding a right-turn lane from southbound U.S. 17- 92/Monroe Road to the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp; and5) Adding a left-turn lane from westbound Seminole Boulevard to U.S. 17-92/ Monroe Road to drive south.
<p>I-4/U.S. 17-92 INTERCHANGE SCHEDULE</p>  <p>FPID No. 242592-6 14</p> <p>#14</p>	<p>The anticipated production schedule for the I-4 and U.S. 17-92 interchange project is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The original design public meeting was held in August 2022;• The project was awarded in June of 2023;• Construction began in October 2023; and• The completion of the project is expected in late 2024.
