



BUILDING A BETTER I-4

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SAND LAKE ROAD (STATE ROAD 482) SAFETY DIVERSIONS FOR BRIDGE DEMOLITION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began demolition of a portion of the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) bridge deck over Sand Lake Road Monday, January 29. The current traffic shift on westbound I-4, in place since October 2023, shifted all westbound I-4 mainline traffic onto new temporary pavement in the median of I-4. This traffic shift provides the space to allow crews to begin bridge demolition work. Crews will demolish the closed section of roadway on the westbound I-4 overpass. Demolition of the bridge will occur in the outermost lanes and is necessary to accommodate the widened I-4 footprint.

To complete this work, Sand Lake Road will be diverted to one lane of traffic intermittently through early March. This will start as early as 11 p.m. each night. Traffic will resume in all lanes by 6 a.m. each morning. This work will not affect current traffic patterns on I-4.



Plans are subject to change. Construction progress, roadway conditions, and weather may require schedule adjustments.



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
