**Meeting called to order at 3:02 p.m.**

**Ryan:** We did hear the devastating news regarding Mr. Rosen and wanted to pass on our condolences from the Department.

**David:** I have been seeing sympathies pouring in from all parts of the country. Thank you, we will pass that along. He was an amazing storyteller.

**Ryan:** Our last contract date has not changed yet, but it will soon as we take holiday days. They should be halting work from December 20 – January 2. We do not have a lot of new activity on our look ahead. We did our deck pour on Monday night. It went well and we have another one scheduled for January. We will be making a video that highlights the progress.

FDOT to Review past 7 days.

- i. Install bridge lighting (Area 1)
- ii. Place and finish lime rock on the westbound I-4 entrance ramp (Area 1)
- iii. Install water main near westbound I-4 entrance ramp (Areas 1 and 2)
- iv. Bridge deck installation (Areas 1, 2, and 3)
- v. Turkey Lake median widening
- vi. Continue installing MSE walls (Area 1)
- vii. Excavate loop ramp (Area 3)



- viii. Install permanent drainage (Area 3)
- ix. Maintain temp drainage (Areas 3 and 4)
- x. Ongoing mowing and litter pickup

**Ryan:** We do not have any new items. We are placing lime rock base on the westbound I-4 entrance ramp. I will be down in Orlando tomorrow and will do a drive through.

**David:** I went through the area, and I received no comments from anyone.

### 2. FDOT to Review next 7-Days.

- i. Bridge deck installation (Areas 1, 2, and 3)
- ii. Turkey Lake median widening

- iv. Excavate loop ramp (Area 3)
- v. Grade and sod around retention pond
- vi. Maintain temp drainage (Areas 3 and 4)
- vii. Utility relocation

**Ryan:** This is slightly different. The grading sod near the retention ponds appears to be the only new work on this schedule.

**James Robinson:** We are going to start doing the relocation of Duke lighting at the Turkey Lake Road and Sand Lake Road intersection on the southwest corner, near the bank, between February and early March. That intersection will be dark so I anticipate you will have people reach out about that.

**David:** Who is responsible for temporary lighting?

**James Robinson:** I believe the county is renting out temporary lighting, but it may be supplied by FDOT.

**Jim:** How long will we be without lights?

**James Robinson:** From the way I read it, that whole area will go away and not return.

**Jim:** We will have to look into this because I do not know if our plans reference this. We do have some minor changes in that area, but I don't believe this is covered.

**Krista:** We have a sidewalk project but that is a ways in the future.

**Jim:** If you can find out when that resurfacing project will take place?

**Krista:** Yes, of course.
