## Traffic Advisory: Westbound I-4 Entrance Ramp from Sand Lake Road to Close Overnight January 23 and 28

**ORANGE COUNTY, Fla.** – Motorists should be advised that a full closure of the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramp from Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) is scheduled to take place overnight on Thursday, January 23, and Tuesday, January 28.

The closure on January 23 is scheduled to start as soon as 10 p.m. and is expected to reopen by 5 a.m. the next morning. The closure is necessary for paving operations.

The closure on January 28 is scheduled to start as soon as 9 p.m. and is expected to reopen by 6 a.m. the next morning. The closure is necessary to shift traffic onto the new westbound I-4 entrance ramp from Sand Lake Road, which is part of the ongoing improvement project at I-4 and Sand Lake Road.

Motorists traveling on Sand Lake Road who wish to access westbound I-4 should travel north on Turkey Lake Road and turn right onto eastbound Hollywood Way. Drivers will then turn right onto Adventure Way and proceed south to the westbound I-4 entrance ramp. See the attached detour map.

FDOT advises motorists to follow all posted detour signs and remain cautious and alert while driving through construction zones. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
