Traffic Advisory: Westbound I-4 Entrance Ramps from Central Florida Parkway to Close Overnight November 12

ORANGE COUNTY, Fla. – Motorists should be advised that a full closure of the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramps from Central Florida Parkway is scheduled to take place overnight on Tuesday, November 12.

The closure is scheduled to start as soon as 8:30 p.m. and access is expected to be restored by 6:30 a.m. the next morning. This closure is necessary for milling and resurfacing the new westbound I-4 entrance ramp from Central Florida Parkway.

Motorists traveling west on Central Florida Parkway who wish to access westbound I-4 should continue past the I-4 interchange to turn left onto southbound Palm Parkway. Drivers will proceed south on Palm Parkway, turn left onto southbound Apopka-Vineland Road (State Road (S.R.) 535), and keep right to access the entrance ramp to westbound I-4. See the attached detour map.

FDOT advises motorists to follow all posted detour signs. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

This work is part of the I-4 improvement project at I-4 and Daryl Carter Parkway. For more information on the planned improvements on I-4, visit the project website at i4beyond.com/darylcarter.
