Meeting called to order at 3:05 p.m.

Ryan: We are 46% complete. You will see a blue line that highlights the construction team's training. We attended a conference over the past two days. It was nice getting together with other professionals in the field to discuss what kind of work is being done. Looking at the look ahead schedule, you will notice nothing new from previous ones. We should be receiving a new aerial shortly.

Ryan: I understand. From our side there's a bit of delay for the maps to update. They use real data from motorists traveling through and after a little bit of time it automatically populates to the new pattern.

David: If they could utilize Universal Boulevard or Kirkman Road that would be better so there is no congestion. At least for the first few months. Dumping all that traffic to Sand Lake Road is a problem.

Carter: We have way finding signs funneling down Kirkman and Universal. We will have signs on the Beachline as well.

David: Great!



Jim: In December the signing plans were approved from Orlando Operations. We were only looking from the perspective of our signs in the project limits and not from the perspective of the new park. Those plans may be available.
