Traffic Advisory: I-4 Entrance Ramps from Sand Lake Road to Close Overnight March 24 and 26

ORANGE COUNTY, Fla. – Motorists are advised that the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance ramp from Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R) 482) will be closed overnight on Monday, March 24 for underground drainage work and paving operations. Should this work not be completed as scheduled on March 24, the closure would take place on the night of Tuesday, March 25, and reopen early the morning of Wednesday, March 26.

The eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from Sand Lake Road will be closed overnight on Wednesday, March 26 for paving operations. Should this work not be completed as scheduled on March 26, the closure would take place on the night of Thursday, March 27, and reopen early the morning of Friday, March 28.

Both ramp closures are scheduled to begin as early as 10 p.m. each night and are expected to reopen by 5 a.m. the following morning.

During the westbound I-4 entrance ramp closure, motorists on Sand Lake Road who wish to access westbound I-4 should travel north on Turkey Lake Road and turn right onto eastbound Hollywood Way. Drivers will then turn right onto Adventure Way and proceed south to the westbound I-4 entrance ramp. See the attached map for detailed detour information.

During the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp closure, motorists on Sand Lake Road who wish to access eastbound I-4 should head north on Kirkman Road (S.R. 435) and proceed to the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp. Alternatively, motorists can head north on Turkey Lake Road, turn right onto eastbound Hollywood Way, and then turn right onto southbound Universal Boulevard to access eastbound I-4.
