Meeting called to order at 3:00 p.m.

Ryan: Our last contract day remains the same. Nothing groundbreaking has hit the schedule. We did the traffic shift on the westbound off ramp to prepare for a larger shift in the future. We will be getting a new aerial soon.

- i. Prepping for jack and bore (Areas 2 and 3)
- ii. Maintaining existing and installing new Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Systems (Areas 3, 6, and 7)
- iii. Lighting (Areas 2, 3, 5, 6, and 7)
- iv. Turkey Lake median widening
- v. Bridge deck installation (Areas 1, 2, and 3)
- vi. Continue installing MSE walls (Area 1)
- vii. Paving (Areas 2, 6, and 7)
- viii. Utility relocation
- ix. Ongoing mowing and litter pickup

Ryan: The jack and bore will be scheduled within the next seven days. The prep work on the bridge installation is here although I do believe the bridge pour will shift. I was out there last night and drove through several times. I think it looks pretty good.

David: I went through the area and did not see anything. Even with the high winds I did not see any barrels on their side.

Brian: I drove it today. A lot is going on, it looks great. I did not see any equipment down. A tenant pointed out the no right turn on red when coming from westbound I-4 to Sand Lake Road as a benefit. The tenant mentioned when going from Turkey Lake and making the right onto Sand Lake, people are trying to get over two lanes which is causing congestion, so they suggested having no turns on red.

Leeland: We did bring this up to traffic operation and they installed a sign that says no right turn until after fully stop.

Ryan: Do you happen to know if that change is in the final configuration?

Leeland: I have to look at it, I am not 100%.

David: This will only continue to get worse if it is not addressed.

Ryan: We can see what we can do.
