Ryan: We did the deck pour last night and the concrete is curing. There are no new activities on our schedule. We are a few weeks from new aerials.

Ryan: I was out there on Thursday and drove through the site and had nothing to note.

Maria: I do have a couple comments over the past few months. Everyone thinks if we get a no turn on red sign at Turkey Lake Road and Sand Lake Road, that it would be a real help. Does that seem possible?



Ryan: It is in the final condition as a no right turn. Right now, it is in place due to cycling to prevent northbound Turkey Lake Road from backing up. We will be realigning the DDI over the next several months and removing the left turn access to Turkey Lake Road. When that happens, there will be an additional lane.

David: Does that follow suit with International Drive? Will they be allowed to turn right?

Ryan: I do not think we have anything in our plans about that. Orange County covers that intersection, but we can reach out and discuss options.
