Meeting called to order at 3:01 p.m.

Ryan: We are continuing to work on westbound I-4. Keeping our eyes on the tropics as the season begins. We are about a week away from getting a new aerial shot.

1. FDOT to Review past 7 days.

 - vii. Grade for sod (Areas 2 and 3)
 - viii. Place lime rock (Areas 2 and 3)
 - ix. Turkey Lake Road median widening
 - x. Utility relocation
 - xi. Ongoing mowing and litter pickup

Ryan: Thermoplastic striping has been occurring. This is more of a permanent form of striping. We are still demolishing the old ramp in area 3. Placing lime rock in area 2 and 3. Turkey Lake has been ongoing for the past four months.



2. Committee's Comments & Suggestions

David: None, that came my way. We had a question about the timing of lights. I assume that will be updated at each phase.

Leeland: Yes, the first couple days they made small tweaks. Now it is much better. A lot of the dirt work and painting has been pushed due to rain. They completed the eastbound I-4 mowing. They should be about halfway down with westbound I-4. They did a great job of cleaning out the concrete debris and drainage from the work site.

David: I noticed a lot of gravel on the shoulder of I-4. Is this what you are referring to?

Leeland: No, just in our loop ramp site.

David: Who is taking care of the shoulder?

Leeland: The area within the work zone would be Lane.

Ryan: Our approach slabs have been discussed. Jack and bore is being pushed due to rain. We have some new lighting and embankment work occurring in this schedule.

Ryan: The plan is to run from where it currently ends to just east of S.R. 536. I think you are discussing the Moving I-4 Forward work that is occurring west of S.R. 536.

Esther: It is a lot of moving parts, but we are working together with the team.
