Meeting called to order at 3:04 p.m.

Ryan: I talked to David and Maria about this yesterday. Our last contract day has changed. Due to some delays and added work, our new last day of contract time is December 19, 2027. That will bring us back to less than 50% in progress. July 3 was given as a holiday by Governor DeSantis. We are allowing our contractors to work, but no road or lane closures. Not too much has changed in this image. The one thing I noticed from this aerial is our Area 2 has expanded.

Ryan: We are anticipating a traffic shift on westbound I-4. Working on soil work in Areas 6 and 7. Placing base material in Areas 2 and 3. It has not rained in a while, so the grass is growing slower.
