Traffic Advisory: Eastbound I-4 Exit Ramp to Sand Lake Road (Exit 74A) to Close Overnight on August 26

ORANGE COUNTY, Fla. – Motorists are advised that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is closing the eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) exit ramp to Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) at Exit 74A overnight on Tuesday, August 26, for overhead sign removal. The ramp closure is scheduled to begin as early as 10 p.m. on Tuesday and is expected to reopen by 5 a.m. Wednesday.

Detour Information for August 26th Overnight Ramp Closure

Motorists traveling on eastbound I-4 who wish to access Sand Lake Road (Exit 74A) will continue east and take Exit 75A at Universal Boulevard. Drivers will then turn right onto southbound Universal Boulevard and proceed to Sand Lake Road. Please see the attached map for detailed detour information.

FDOT advises motorists to follow all posted detour signs. Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
