Turkey Lake Road Overnight Work: Expect Nightly Diversions Jan. 14 through mid-February

Sunday through Thursday nights | 10 p.m. – 6 a.m. | between Phillips Village plaza and Sand Lake Road

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is implementing overnight safety diversions to mill and resurface this segment of Turkey Lake Road as part of the Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) interchange project.

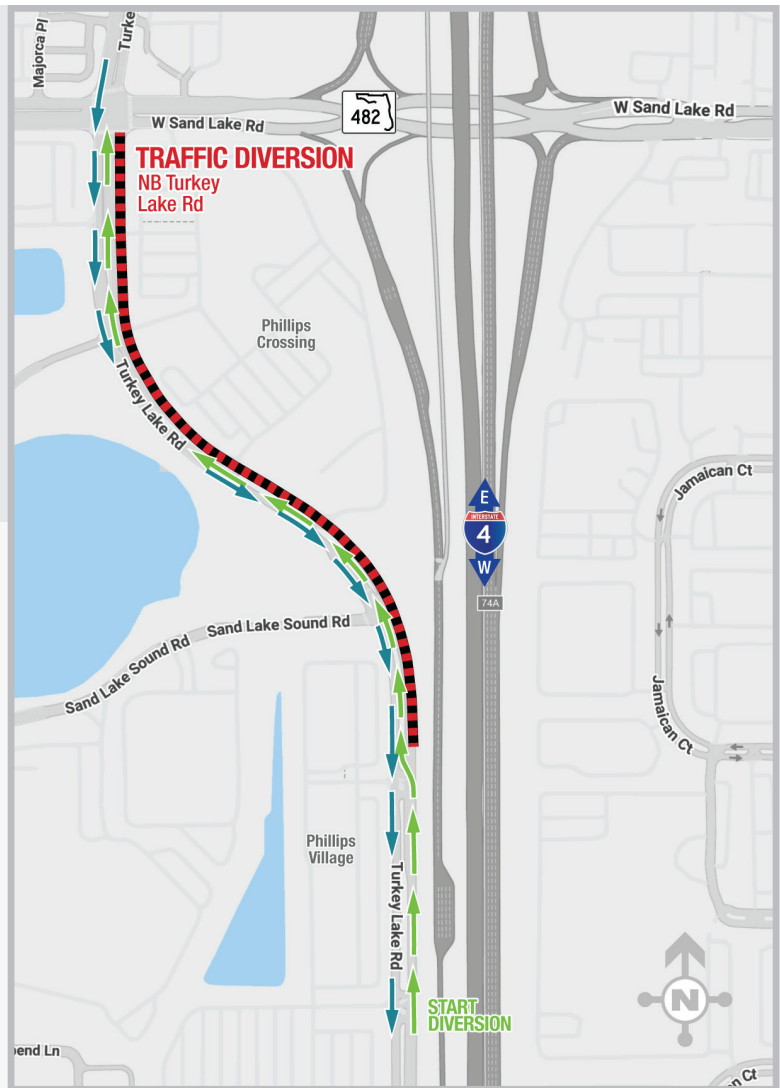
Crews will alternate between the northbound and southbound work zones but will only implement diversions in one direction at a time.

ON NORTHBOUND PAVING NIGHTS:

- Turkey Lake Road will remain open with one lane in both directions through the work zone.
- Northbound traffic will be diverted to one inside lane on the southbound side.
- Southbound motorists will be limited to the single outside lane.
- Cones, barrels, and signage will guide drivers through the work zone.
- Stay alert, follow signage, and drive with caution.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work is expected to begin on Wednesday night, January 14, in the northbound direction.
- Once crews finish the first phase of paving on northbound Turkey Lake Road, they will begin paving the same segment in the southbound direction. The southbound work requires all southbound lanes to be diverted. See the other side for details.
- Diversions and work will continue to switch between northbound and southbound until paving operations are complete.
- Because the schedule may shift based on progress and conditions, the best way to know what to expect on any given night is to check the project webpage here: fdot.tips/TurkeyLakeRoad.

Turkey Lake Road Overnight Work: Expect Nightly Diversions Jan. 14 through mid-February

ON SOUTHBOUND PAVING NIGHTS:

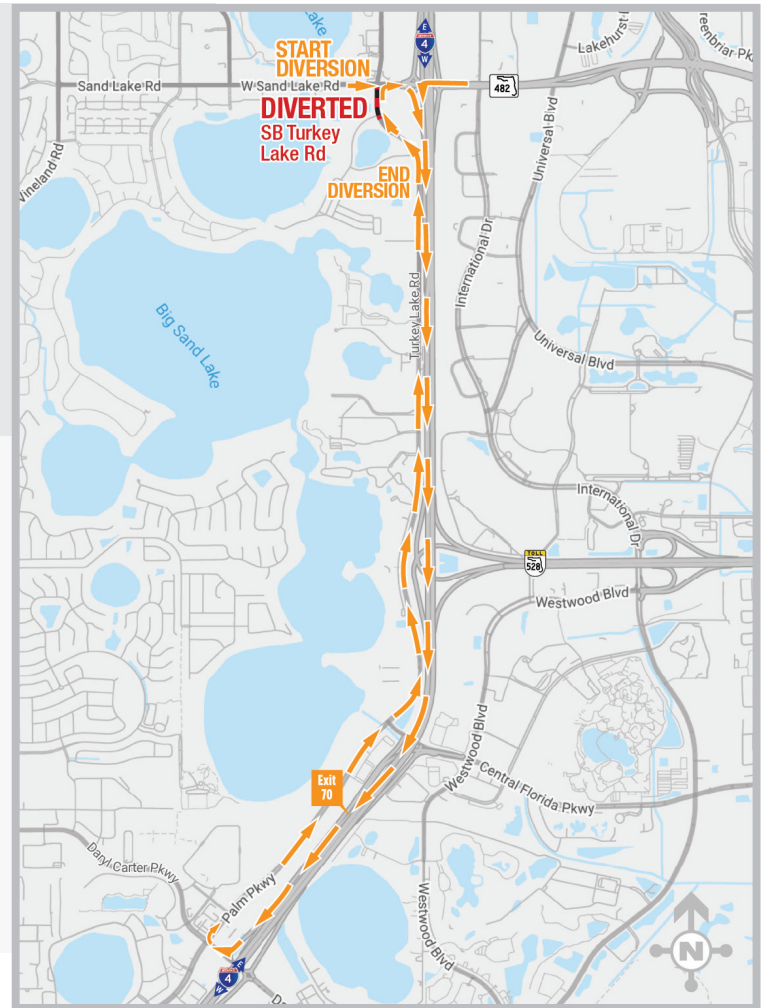
- All southbound traffic on Turkey Lake Road between Phillips Village shopping plaza and Sand Lake Road will be diverted.
- All northbound lanes of Turkey Lake Road will remain open on southbound paving nights.
- Stay alert, follow signage, drive with caution, and allow for extra travel time.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Work is expected to begin on Wednesday night, January 14, in the northbound direction. See the other side for details.
- Once crews finish the first phase of paving on northbound Turkey Lake Road, they will begin paving the same segment in the southbound direction. The southbound work requires all lanes to be diverted as detailed below.
- Diversions and work will continue to switch between northbound and southbound until paving operations are complete.
- Because the schedule may shift based on progress and conditions, the best way to know what to expect on any given night is to check the project webpage here: fdot.tips/TurkeyLakeRoad.

Southbound Turkey Lake Road Diversion Route

- Use the westbound I-4 entrance ramp.
- From westbound I-4, take Exit 70, turning right onto westbound Daryl Carter Parkway.
- From there, motorists can either turn left to continue south on Palm Parkway or turn right onto north Palm Parkway, which becomes Turkey Lake Road north of Central Florida Parkway.
