Traffic Advisory: Overnight Closures of Southbound Turkey Lake Road January 28 and 29

ORANGE COUNTY, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is implementing overnight closures of all lanes of southbound Turkey Lake Road just south of Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) on Wednesday night, January 28, and Thursday night, January 29, beginning as early as 10 p.m. and reopening by 6 a.m. the following morning.

The closures are necessary for crews to complete milling and resurfacing of southbound Turkey Lake Road. This work is part of the ongoing improvement project to reconstruct the Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road interchange into a diverging diamond interchange (DDI).

Detour Information

To access Turkey Lake Road south of Sand Lake Road during the closure:

- From westbound I-4, continue past the Sand Lake Road exit and take Exit 70, turning right onto westbound Daryl Carter Parkway. From there, either turn left to continue south on Palm Parkway or turn right onto north Palm Parkway, which becomes Turkey Lake Road north of Central Florida Parkway.
- From Sand Lake Road, use the westbound I-4 entrance ramp and proceed to Daryl Carter Parkway (Exit 70). From there, follow the same steps as above.

In the coming weeks, crews will alternate between paving southbound and northbound Turkey Lake Road between Sand Lake Road and south of Sand Lake Sound Road. Closures will only be implemented in one direction at a time. Southbound paving operations require a detour, while northbound paving requires traffic to be reduced to a single lane in both directions.

Because the schedule and closure direction may shift based on progress and weather conditions, the best way to know what to expect on any given night is to check the project webpage here: fdot.tips/TurkeyLakeRoad.
