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Traffic Advisory: Overnight Left-Turn Lane Closures at Sand Lake Road and Turkey Lake Road Intersection to Begin June 28

ORANGE COUNTY, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will intermittently close left-turn lanes at the intersection of Sand Lake Road (State Road (S.R.) 482) and Turkey Lake Road beginning as early as Sunday, June 28. The closures are scheduled to begin at 11 p.m. each night and are expected to end by 6 a.m. the following morning.

Closures will occur intermittently and will vary by night based on construction activities. Multiple left-turn movements may be restricted at the same time.

The closures are scheduled for the following nights:

- Sunday, June 28, through Wednesday, July 1
- Monday, July 6, through Thursday, July 9
- Sunday, July 12, and Monday, July 13

The final closure is expected to end the morning of Tuesday, July 14.

During the closures, detours will be in place and signage will guide drivers around the work zone. Motorists should follow all posted signs, plan for extra travel time, and consider alternative routes.

These closures are necessary for force main installation at the Sand Lake Road and Turkey Lake Road intersection as part of the Interstate 4 (I-4) and Sand Lake Road interchange improvement project.

Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
